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Subject: Allocation of street name within Clydebank Business Park, Clydebank

- 1. Purpose
- **1.1** To allocate a street name to an existing service road accessed from North Avenue within Clydebank Business Park.
- 2. Background
- 2.1 Labelgraphics Limited are currently constructing a new two storey production and warehouse unit on a vacant site within Clydebank Business Park. The new site will be accessed from an existing unnamed service road at the westmost end of North Avenue and as a result of the development the road requires to be named.
- 3. Main Issues
- 3.1 Labelgraphics Ltd. have suggested a street name for consideration. They have suggested Mulvenny Court; in recognition of the work carried out by their founder and current chairman Alex Mulvenny MBE. Elsewhere within Clydebank Business Park the names of Engineers have been used as a theme for naming streets. A suitable name for consideration which would follow the engineer theme is Murdoch; after Scottish Engineer William Murdoch who was involved in the application of gas lighting, as well as steam engine and locomotive design.
