		 discussion with a PT/class teachers from a department (s) that has shown improvement in performance from the previous year.
		Eg if you identified the following areas from last years improvement plan - Co-op learning, literacy across the curriculum, leadership, mathematics
		For example: Director - class to see co-op learning in action
		Head of service – talking to a group of pupils who have been on leadership course
		QIM or QIO - class to see literacy being developed across the curriculum
		Visiting headteacher – discussion with mathematics PT/class teacher(s) on what has moved the department forward in the past year.
