Subject: Boundary Fencing, Mountblow

1. Purpose

1.1 To advise the Committee of tenders received for the Boundary Fencing, Mountblow and to seek approval to accept the most economically advantageous tender.

2. Background

2.1 Tenders for the project were received on 4 June 2008 from three contractors.

3. Main Issues

3.1 The work comprises the removal of redundant fencing/hedging and installation of new metal bow top fencing to council dwellings throughout Mountblow.

4. Personnel Issues

- **4.1** Design and Quantity Surveying services are being carried out in-house by the Architectural Services Section of Housing, Environmental and Economic Development.
- **4.2** CDM Regulations compliance is being undertaken by CDM Scotland Ltd. who were appointed to act as CDM Coordinator for the Council.

5. Financial Implications

5.1 The three lowest tenders have been checked arithmetically and represent good value by current pricing levels and can be accommodated within the Housing Capital Budget. Adjustments have been made where appropriate in accordance with the code of tendering procedure (see Appendix 1 - Statement of Tenders Received).

6. Risk Analysis

6.1 All risks have been fully considered in the contract documentation and appropriate measures will be incorporated in the construction phase health and safety plan for the project in accordance with the CDM Regulations 2005.

7. Conclusions

- **7.1** The works included in this contract will improve the security of each of the buildings as well as providing a more aesthetically appealing frontage to each of the properties.
- 8. Recommendation
- 8.1 The Committee is invited to approve the awarding of the contract to Hay and Anderson (Kilwinning) Ltd in the amount of £109,933.65 as the most economically advantageous tender.
