- **2.1** Mr. Ness submitted an application for renewal of a Taxi /Private Hire Car Driver's Licence to the Council on 5 April 2012.

There is, however, provision in the legislation for the Licensing Authority to entertain a late representation which has been received before a final decision has been made if the Licensing Authority is satisfied that there is sufficient reason why the representation had not been made in the time required.
- **3.3** The terms of the letter from the Police will be made known to the Committee at the meeting as appropriate.
