NATIONAL EFFICIENCY MEASURES: SUMMARY OF ASSUMPTIONS MADE

Appendix 3 lists the National Efficiency Measures (NEMs) developed in late 2006 by the consultants Aspiren working for the Improvement Service and CoSLA. The 2006/07 efficiency figures have been calculated by using the respective formulas for both 2006/07 and the previous year 2005/06 to allow a calculation of the movement in the measure from April 2006 to March 2007.

The following assumptions have been made in arriving at these efficiency measures:

- 1. An inflation rate of 2% has been applied to the baseline figures for 2005/06 in respect of all NEM's calculated.
- 2. NEM CL1: This includes departmental support costs but excludes corporate support costs.
- 3. NEM's CHN1 and CHN2: The "number of school children" has been based on school census data as at September in each year.
- 4. NEM CHN3: The "number of children transported to school" is based on data as at October 2005 (2005/06) and February 2007 (2006/07).
- 5. NEM SW2: The costs of single status have been ignored in arriving at this calculation.
- 6. NEM's PP1 and PP2: The "total population" of the West Dunbartonshire Council area is based on the General Registrar's midyear estimates (30 June) for both 2005/06 and 2006/07.
- 7. NEM's RG2 and RG3: The "number of housing units" is based on the mid year figure.
- 8. NEM CS1: The "total number of dwellings" is based on the number of dwellings as at 31 March in each year.
- 9. NEM CS2: The "number of FTE permanent staff" is based on the figures used for the Joint Staffing Watch.
- 10. Where relevant, calculations are based on management accounts rather than the BVACOP version of figures.
