**Subject: Allocation of Street Names for a New Development off Cochno Road,
Clydebank.**

1. Purpose

- 1.1** To allocate street names for a new housing development.

2. Background

- 2.1** The development by Mactaggart & Mickel Ltd. consists of thirty nine detached dwellings, accessed via two roads off Cochno Road.
- 2.2** The site is a former green field site.

3. Main Issues

- 3.1** Mactaggart and Mickel have requested that the name “Cochno Brae” is allocated to this development.
- 3.2** Two street names are required in this development and therefore “Cochno Rise” is also proposed.

4. Personnel Issues

- 4.1** There are no personnel issues.

5. Financial Implication

- 5.1** There are no financial implications.

6. Risk Analysis

- 6.1** There are no known risks to the Council.

7. Conclusion

- 7.1** As the site is accessed off “Cochno Road” and as the name is familiar in the locale, it would be appropriate that the name “Cochno” form part of the new street names.

8. Recommendation

8.1 It is therefore recommended that the proposed streets be named “Cochno Brae” and “Cochno Rise”.
