**Subject: Street naming for new development off Dumbarton Road, Bowling.**

#### **1. Purpose**

- 1.1** To approve names for three new streets within a new housing development in Bowling.

#### **2. Background**

- 2.1** Three sites, being built by J & A Developments Ltd, consist of seventy one flatted dwellings, and will be accessed off Dumbarton Road in Bowling.
- 2.2** The new development is being built on the grounds of the former Littlemill Distillery.

#### **3. Main Issues**

- 3.1** J & A Developments Ltd requested that the name "Littlemill" be retained to maintain a link to the previous use of the site.
- 3.2** Three street names are required.

#### **4. Personnel Issues**

There are no personnel issues.

#### **5. Financial Implications**

There are no financial implications.

#### **6. Risk Analysis**

There are no known risks to the Council.

## **7. Conclusion**

- 7.1** As the sites are in the vicinity of the former Littlemill Distillery it would seem appropriate to include “Littlemill” as part of the new street names for the development.

**It is recommended that the new streets be named “Littlemill Place”, “Littlemill Court” and “Littlemill Gate”.**
