## **STATEMENT OF TENDERS**

There was submitted statement of tenders received by the Director of Roads and Technical Services in respect of the Comprehensive Area Renewal Project, Central Area, Clydebank, Phase I.

The Committee, approved the acceptance of the tender submitted by Cruden Building Renewals Ltd in the sum of £586,577.22 and the additional environmental works which might be added to the contract by the Director of Social Work and Housing at the cost of £50,000, if required.

## **WHITECROOK PRIMARY SCHOOL - TOILET ADAPTATIONS**

There was submitted report by the Director of Roads and Technical Services requesting delegated authority to accept the lowest tender received at the closing date of 12 noon on 16th September 1998 for the proposed toilet adaptations at Whitecreek Primary School without delay.

The Committee agreed that the Director of Roads and Technical Services, in consultation with the Director of Education and Leisure Services and the Convener of the Tendering Committee, be authorised to accept the lowest tender in respect of the aforesaid project.

## **HIGH FLATS - NEW ROOFS - BELLSMYRE AND WEST BRIDGEND (3 BLOCKS)**

There was submitted report by the Director of Roads and Technical Services seeking approval to invite tenders from contractors not on the Council's approved list in respect of a project for renewal of roofing waterproof membranes with a proprietary roofing system manufactured by Sarnafil Ltd.

The Committee, following consideration, agreed that the two contractors on the Sarnafil Ltd., Register of recommended contractors, not already on the Council's approved list, be included on the tender list in respect of the project for renewal of roofing waterproof membranes at the high flats at Bellsmyre and West Bridgend (3 blocks).
