**Subject: Planning Application DC07/110/FUL: Erection of 30 Flats and 27
Terraced Dwellinghouses with Associated Access Road and
Parking at Dumbarton Road, Duntocher by Gladedale Limited.**

1. Purpose

- 1.1** The purpose of this supplementary report is to address the issues raised by the Planning Committee of 8 August 2007 with regard to the above planning application.

2. Background

- 2.1** The above application was presented to the Planning Committee on 8 August 2007 which agreed to continue the application pending:
- (i) Duntocher Tenants and Residents Association being consulted on the application.
 - (ii) Report on the disposal of an area of ground by West Dunbartonshire Council in relation to proposed development.

3. Main Issues

- 3.1** Duntocher Tenants and Residents Association were consulted on the application on 10/08/07. At the time of preparing this report no response has been received. Should such a response be received then a verbal report will be made to the Committee.
- 3.2** The sale of adjacent Council owned land was considered at the Community Safety Environmental Services Committee meeting of 7 September 2005. At that meeting it was agreed to sell sufficient land to facilitate an appropriate development on the site of the former hotel.
