The Chart above presents evidence of:

1. The rate of alcohol hospital admissions, normalised to represent the number per 100,000 population and the comparison (1a) with the Scottish rate (where Scottish rate = 100%). This is the 2004-2008 averaged data, and was used in the original Overprovision Report to the Licensing Board
2. The rate of Emergency alcohol hospital admissions normalised to represent the number per 100,000 population. This is the 2009 data, and presents a slightly different data capture than that which was used in the original Overprovision Report. This revised data capture has been recommended by the Public Health Department at Greater Glasgow and Clyde NHS Board.
3. The rate of Emergency alcohol hospital admissions, normalised to represent the number per 100,000 population and the comparison (3a) with the Scottish rate (where Scottish rate = 100%). This is the 2010 data, and presents a slightly different data capture than that which was used in the original Overprovision Report.
4. The rate of alcohol related deaths, normalised to represent the number per 100,000 population and the comparison (4a) with the Scottish rate (where Scottish rate = 100%). This is the 2004-08 averaged data, and was used in the original Overprovision Report to the Licensing Board
5. The rate of alcohol related deaths, normalised to represent the number per 100,000 population and the comparison (5a) with the Scottish rate (where Scottish rate = 100%). This is the 2008-10 averaged data, and compares directly with data used in the original Overprovision Report to the Licensing Board

With all the data provided, there is some fluctuation in the data, and wider comparisons should be used where possible.
