GARSHAKE – 4TH FLOOR TRANSFORMATION PROJECT

A report was submitted by the Executive Director of Housing, Environmental and Economic Development advising of the tender process for the procurement of building works to refurbish the former canteen and kitchen on the 4th floor of the Council Offices, Garshake Road, Dumbarton into office accommodation to establish a workplace for the future, and seeking approval for the award of the contract for the project.
