KNOWLE BURN FLOOD PREVENTION SCHEME

A report was submitted by the Executive Director of Housing, Environmental and Economic Development advising of tender returns received for the Knowle Burn Flood Prevention Scheme and seeking approval to accept the most advantageous tender.

Following discussion and having heard the Manager of Roads & Transportation in further explanation of the report and in answer to a Member's question, the Committee agreed to approve the awarding of the contract to George Leslie Ltd in the amount of £2,474,906.57, subject to it being confirmed to the Chair that Legal Services was satisfied that the award of the contract was in accordance with the decision taken by Council at its adjourned meeting on 3 April 2013 in respect of 'Blacklisting of Trade Unionists' (Pages XXX refer).
