## ALEXANDRIA - HEATHER AVENUE - CARE HOME AND ASSOCIATED HOUSING SITES

A report was submitted by the Executive Director of Infrastructure and Regeneration advising on the result of on-going negotiations with the developer and proposed operator of a 60 bed care home on a site at Heather Avenue, Alexandria.

Having heard the Head of Regeneration and Economic Development and the Assets Coordinator in further explanation of the report and in answer to Members' questions, the Committee agreed:-

(1) that authority be delegated to the Executive Director of Infrastructure and Regeneration to agree terms for the creation of a wayleave and servitude through the Council owned site at Heather Avenue, Alexandria to Sedden Alexandria Ltd at a restricted price of £35,000; and (2) that authority be delegated to the Head of Legal, Democratic and Regulatory Services to enter into the appropriate documentation, subject to such legal conditions that are considered appropriate.
