Subject : Corporate Debt Policy

1. Purpose

1.1 The purpose of this report is to update Committee on the progress of developing a Corporate Debt Policy.

2. Background

2.1 The Corporate and Efficient Governance Committee in August 2008 noted that the draft Corporate Debt Policy was being reviewed by relevant stakeholders and that a further report would be submitted to Committee in October at the conclusion of the consultation process.

3. Main Issues

- **3.1** An inter-departmental working group has been formed to lead the consultation process. Representatives from the Citizens Advice Bureau and the Independent Resource Centre participated in the group.
- **3.2** There is a seminar for elected Members on 22 October to review the draft policy and Members not able to attend the seminar have been provided with the opportunity to submit written comments.
- **3.3** A verbal update will be provided to Committee regarding the outcome of the Members' seminar.

4. Personnel Issues

4.1 There are no personnel issues.

5. Financial Implications

5.1 The Council's ability to deliver services which meet the needs of its citizens depends heavily on its success in collecting revenues.

6. Risk Analysis

6.1 The Council has a fiduciary duty to collect all sums due to it. A corporate debt policy will seek to ensure the Council operates in a fair, equal and objective way when recovering debts.

7. Conclusions

7.1 The introduction of a corporate debt policy will seek to ensure the Council operates in a proper manner when recovering debts.
