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**Subject: Street Naming for new Development off Old Mill Road, Duntocher, Clydebank**

#### **1. Purpose**

- 1.1** To seek Committee approval to allocate a street name for a new housing development.

#### **2. Background**

- 2.1** Prior to redevelopment, the site was formerly occupied by J & T McColgan, (Funeral Directors), garage facilities, a dwelling, several lock-ups and a Scout hall.
- 2.2** The development, by Forthwood Limited, consists of 30 flats arranged into 5 blocks.
- 2.3** Burnbrae is the name of a street adjacent to the new development.

#### **3. Main Issues**

- 3.1** Forthwood Limited has proposed Burnbrae Gardens or Burnbrae Court as a new street name for the development. This is in keeping with a name known in the area.
