1	Kilmaronock	Memorial base requires pointing work and memorial and base require specialist cleaning. Lettering on the name plate needs to be painted	No work presently scheduled pending consideration by Community Council to relocate memorial
2	Balloch North Parish Church	No work required	
3	Christie Park Cenotaph	Slate name plates are wearing leading to obscure lettering. Memorial requires cleaning and pointing. Steps and surrounding hardstanding area requires complete refurbishment	Proposed refurbishment is included within a Funding application being prepared by Greenlight to the National Environment Trust for refurbishment of Christie Park.
4	Vale of Leven Academy	No work required	Memorial will soon be relocated internally within new school.
5	Renton	No work required, extensive construction works / cleaning was carried out when the memorial was moved from Renton primary school to its present location.	
6	Levensgrove Park	The memorial was cleaned and lettering repainted in 2005, the surrounding fence was also painted at this time. Steps and walls leading to the monument were cleaned and repointed.
