Subject: Acquired Brain Injury Awareness Training Session

1. Purpose

1.1 This report informs members of the development of Acquired Brain Injury Awareness training session.

- **2.1** The Acquired Brain Injury Strategy group identified the need for the development of an awareness session for carers and staff from health and social care services.
