MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

9239 The Minutes of Meeting of the Committee held on 26 April 2006 were submitted and approved as a correct record.

MOBILE TELEPHONY PROVISION

9240 A report was submitted by the Chief Executive seeking authority to award the contract for provision of a mobile telephony service for the Council.

9241 Having heard the Section Head – Information Services in explanation and in answer to Members' questions, the Committee agreed:-

- (1) to approve the award of the contract for the provision of the Council's mobile telephony service to T-Mobile for a period of three years with an option to extend it; and
- (2) to note that the cost of the service would be met from individual departmental revenue budgets.

TENDER FOR REPLACEMENT OF FURNITURE/WHITE GOODS FOR HOMELESS UNITS

9242 A report was submitted by the Director of Housing, Regeneration and Environmental Services seeking approval to award the contract for the replacement of furniture/white goods for the Council's 240 homeless units.
