1. Purpose

1.1 To advise the Committee of tenders received for the reroofing of twenty-eight properties in Dalmuir, Clydebank and to recommend acceptance of the most economically advantageous tender.

2.1 Tenders for the project were received on 11 October 2006 from five contractors.

3. Main Issues

3.1 The works comprise the renewal and upgrading of existing flat roofs. Works include the replacement of existing parapet copes and gutters.
