Points were awarded to the four lowest tenders out of a maximum score of 100 to identify the most economic offer
2. The following contractors were invited to tender but declined:- None
3. The date of lodgement of Tenders was 14 January, 2010
4. The date of expiry of Tenders is 13 April, 2010
5. The Head of Finance (Dept. of Corporate Services) has been consulted in accordance with financial regulations.
6. The tender project cost of £486,877.90 can be contained within the Education Capital Budget.
7. A Pre-Construction Information Pack relating to the CDM Regulations was required for this project and has been included in the contract documentation.
8. The Chief Executive Officer and the Executive Director of Educational Services are in agreement with this report.

It is recommended that the tender of *CBC* be selected as the most economically advantageous Tender for the Authority and be approved by the Members of the Tendering Committee.
