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**Subject: Annual Review of the West Dunbartonshire Joint Future Planning Structure**

### **1. Purpose**

**1.1** The report advises the Partnership of the annual review of our Joint Planning Structure.

**1.2** The review is co-ordinated by the Community Care Planning and Implementation Partnership, which includes officers from the NHS and local authority, and a broad representation of West Dunbartonshire community groups.
