Various changes to the licence are proposed, such as:</p> <p>Increase off sale capacity from 10.8m² to 14.92m².</p> <p>Amend off sale hours to allow the sale of alcohol from 10am on Sunday</p> <p>There are also miscellaneous changes proposed to the operating plan:</p> <p>Q4 – Remove seasonal variations Q5 – Allow recorded music within and outwith core hours Q5 – Additional information add– “background recorded music may be played when premises is open” Q5f) – Replace existing with the following wording – “the premises will open outwith core licensed hours for the sale of other goods and provision of services consistent with a filling station/convenience store, the premises may also offer a 'food to go' service, lotto, payment solutions, free ATM.”</p>
