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**Subject: Installation of BSkyB Compatible Satellite/TV/FM Distribution Systems to 23 Blocks, Clydebank (Phase II)**

#### **1. Purpose**

- 1.1** To advise the Committee of tenders received for the communal aerial replacement Contract and to recommend acceptance of the most economically advantageous tender.

#### **2. Background**

- 2.1** Tenders for the project were received on 13 September 2006 from five contractors.

#### **3. Main Issues**

- 3.1** The works comprise the replacement of existing communal aerial systems. Works include the removal of existing aerials, installation and commissioning of new digital systems.

#### **4. Personnel Issues**

- 4.1** Design, Quantity Surveying services and Planning Supervision are being carried out in-house by the Architectural Services Section of Housing, Regeneration and Environmental Services.

#### **5. Financial Implications**

- 5.1** The three lowest tenders have been checked arithmetically and represent good value by current pricing levels. Adjustments have been made where appropriate in accordance with the code of tendering procedure. (see Appendix 1 – Statement of Tenders Received).
