Subject: Street Lighting Programme 2006/2007

1. Purpose

- 1.1** To seek Committee approval of the proposed programme of street lighting revenue and capital works to be carried out in the financial year 2006/2007.

2. Background

- 2.1** The programme includes revenue funding of £100,000 allocated to upgrade and improve the Council's street lighting stock through the revenue budget and £500,000 capital funding for 2006/2007.

3. Main Issues

- 3.1** Projects from the 2005/2006 work programme which have already been approved but not yet fully implemented have been carried forward into the proposed 2006/2007 programme and will be prioritised for early implementation.
- 3.2** The proposed programme of works has been prepared and prioritised with due consideration to the condition of the existing street lighting network. It should be noted that the programme may be subject to disruption and delay as a consequence of public utility operations and/or adverse weather.
- 3.3** The proposed street lighting programme of improvement works is attached as Appendix 1.

4. Personnel Issues

- 4.1** There are no Personnel issues.

5. Financial Implications

- 5.1** The funding for the works will be met from the street lighting revenue and capital budgets for year 2006/2007.

6. Conclusions

- 6.1** The list in Appendix 1 represents the prioritised list of schemes considered to be necessary for investment during 2006/2007.

7. Recommendations

- 7.1** The Committee is invited to approve the proposed street lighting revenue and capital programme of works as detailed in Appendix 1.
