Subject: Wallace Street, Public Lighting

1. Purpose

- 1.1 To advise the Committee of tenders received for improving the public lighting in Wallace Street, Dumbarton and to seek approval to accept the most economically advantageous tender.

2. Background

- 2.1 Tenders for the project were received on 28 November 2007 from six contractors.

3. Main Issues

- 3.1 The works consist of the installation of the new public lighting and the removal of the old units.

4. Personnel Issues

- 4.1 There are no personnel issues.

5. Financial Implications

- 5.1 The six tenders have been checked arithmetically and represent good value by current pricing levels. The summary of prices received are as follows:

Harte Lighting	£ 83,410.00
Lightways Ltd	£ 37,283.53
McGivney Ltd	£ 38,573.35
Glasgow Council	£109,973.71
Centre Great 1991	£ 39,374.04
Amey Roads	£ 44,478.64

- 5.2 The works will be funded from the approved public lighting capital programme.

6. Risk Analysis

- 6.1 Without the proposed works the lighting levels in Wallace Street will be below recommended levels.

7. Conclusions

- 7.1** This scheme will deliver a much needed improvement to public lighting in Wallace Street, Dumbarton.

8. Recommendations

- 8.1** The Committee is invited to approve the awarding of the contract to Lightways Ltd in the amount of £37,283.53 as the most economically advantageous tender.
