Subject: New street names for residential development at Area 4 Lomondgate Dumbarton

1. Purpose

1.1 To allocate five street names for the residential development at Area 4 Lomondgate Dumbarton by Taylor Wimpey.

2. Recommendations

2.1 It is recommended that the Committee approve the additional 5 street names.

3. Background

3.1 Taylor Wimpey require an additional five street names to complete their development of 109 residential properties in Area 4 Lomondgate Dumbarton

4. Main Issues

- **4.1** Taylor Wimpey have adopted the remaining previously approved 'Scottish Glen' names for the first two streets of their development. This is in keeping with the remainder of the residential sites in Lomondgate by Persimmon Homes and The Walker Group.
- 4.2 The following additional street names are proposed -
 - Glen Garry Close
 - Glen Lochy Court
 - Glen Esk Gardens
 - Glen Dessary Lane
 - Glentanar Crescent

These names are in keeping with the general theme of Scottish Glens for this residential development. The five names proposed meet the requirements of the Council's street naming policy.

4.3 In line with the street naming policy the elected members for Ward 2 have been consulted, two elected members had no comment to make and two responded positively. The Community Council of Dumbarton North was inactive during the consultation period.
