EIA 593 details some small differential impacts of charging impacts, that can be mitigated. The Council will follows its Communicating Effectively to ensure accessibility of advice and guidance. The fees have been introduced in line with The Town and Country Planning (Fees for Applications)(Scotland) Regulations 2022, which enables and sets out discretionary fees that the Council can introduce for planning-related services. The fees have been set in line with the Regulations where these are set out, or following benchmarking where the Council has latitude to set its own fees. Exemptions have been introduced where allowed to account for potentially disadvantaged groups, and have been set at an affordable* rate for development types likely to be undertaken by individuals (*when compared with the overall costs of a development project). Many of the fees are also optional.
