MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

The Minutes of Meeting of the Tendering Committee held on 23 January 2008 were submitted and approved as a correct record.

MULTI STOREY FLATS – COMPREHENSIVE AREA RENEWAL, DALMUIR COURT, CLYDEBANK

A report was submitted by the Executive Director of Housing, Environmental and Economic Development advising of tenders received for the Multi Storey Flats – Comprehensive Area Renewal, Dalmuir Court, Clydebank and seeking approval to accept the most economically advantageous tender.

After discussion and having heard the Section Head – Architectural Services, the Committee agreed to approve the awarding of the contract to Concrete Repairs Ltd. in the amount of £1,636,068.93 as the most economically advantageous tender.

TENDER FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF KITCHEN WORKTOPS

A report was submitted by the Executive Director of Housing, Environmental and Economic Development advising of tenders received for the supply and delivery of kitchen worktops and seeking approval to accept the most economically advantageous tender.

After discussion and having heard the Section Head, Housing Maintenance (Clydebank) in further explanation and in answer to Members' questions, it was agreed to approve the awarding of this contract to McNair (Building and Timber Merchant) Ltd. as the most economically advantageous tender.

TENDER FOR THE SUPPLY AND MAINTENANCE OF AN EXTERNALLY MANAGED ANTI-SPAM SERVICE

A report was submitted by the Executive Director of Corporate Services seeking approval to award a contract for an externally managed Anti-spam service.

After discussion and having heard the Section Head, ICT & Business Development in elaboration and in answer to Members' questions, the Committee agreed:-

- (1) to approve the award of this contract to Supplier 5 as referred to in the report, Data Connect, for a period of three years with the option to extend for one further period of 12 months; and
- (2) to note that any extension of this contract would be the subject of a further report to a future meeting of the Tendering Committee.
