**Current:** "Planning Capacity" P1=25 / P2,3=30 / P4-7=33 => 1 Stream school = 217 pupils (for more than 217 but less than 434 pupils, see attached Appendix I)

"Working Capacity" The capacity resulting in the Authority's policy in any school session to introduce multiple teachers in the classroom(s) and/or where a number of composite classes are required.

"Legal Capacity" 1.7 m<sup>2</sup> per pupil (traditional plan) / 1.5m<sup>2</sup> per pupil (open plan)/ 1.5m<sup>2</sup> for secondaries (GP)
