Subject: Street name for new housing development site at the former Highdykes Primary School, Braehead, Bonhill

1. PURPOSE

- 1.1** To allocate a street name to a road within the new housing development former Highdykes Primary School, Braehead, Bonhill,

2. RECOMMENDATIONS

- 2.1** It is recommended that Highdykes Hill to be approved as the street name.

3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1** Permission was granted for 49 affordable housing units. The new street will be a single vehicular access leading from Braehead into a no-through road.

4. MAIN ISSUES

- 4.1** The street name proposed for consideration is Highdykes Hill. The site is accessed directly off of Braehead. The community and the children who attended the school used to refer to it as “the wee school at the top of the hill”.

The street name is derived from the former primary school (Highdykes) and its location, it is also in keeping with the local knowledge of the area. The name proposed meets the requirement of the Council’s Street Naming Policy.
