The Mountblow Community Centre is not large enough for polling. In 2007, the view of the Access Panel was sought and the Secretary confirmed that the premises would not be suitable.

The only alternative to the Community Centre is the use of portacabins which are very unpopular with the public and there are security and safety concerns regarding the proposed location of the portacabins on Melbourne Avenue.

2) Councillor Marie McNair

Suggested using Dalmuir Community Learning and Development Centre as a polling place for voters in WC23.

The Social Room would be a suitable polling place but the Centre would need to be closed to the public on the Wednesday evening and all day Thursday for security purposes.

Returning Officer's Comments:

This is a large polling place which accommodates voters from Wards 5 and 6. Fewer polling stations are required at a Parliamentary election because voters do not have to be divided by ward. The Council may wish to consider using the Dalmuir Community Learning and Development (CL&D) Centre as a polling place for voters in Polling District WC23 as this will also reduce the number of voters using the church hall which can be busy. If this is agreed then this would leave four polling stations within Dalmuir Barclay Parish Church hall and three would be required within Dalmuir CL&D Centre.
