02 – Community Care

1. Total number of respite weeks provided to all clients groups;
2. Percentage of carers who say they feel they are able to continue to care;
3. Percentage of people receiving a service following an assessment in line with Council and National Eligibility Criteria;
4. Percentage of people aged 65 and over with intensive care needs being supported at home;
5. Percentage of people aged 65 and also who receive 20 or more interventions per week;
6. Percentage of all Adult Support and Protection clients who have current risk assessments and care plan;
7. Percentage of Care Plan Reviews carried out within agreed timescale; and
8. Value of benefits maximised through representation from Welfare Rights Money Advice Service.

03 – Criminal Justice Social Work

9. Percentage of Statutory Orders completed successfully.

07 – Child protection and Children's Social Work

10. Rate per 1,000 of children/young people aged 8-18 who are referred to the Reporter on offence-related grounds;
11. Percentage of children and young people on Child Protection Register who have a current risk assessment and care plan;
12. Percentage of children and young people who are supported at home under statutory supervision; and
13. Number of children and young people leaving care who move onto positive destinations.
